Start the conversation by asking...

Go deeper with this...

Connect to God's truth by sharing...

- Constantly striving for unity is a big part of maturity.
- We need to be mature enough to know that not all fights are worth the division, especially among people who all follow Christ.
- And yet, quarrels and division seem inevitable. How can we maintain unity as Christians?
- Unity requires effort!
- Unity happens when we build each other up.
- Unity happens when we focus on God rather than on what divides us.
- Humility, gentleness, and patience are crucial for walking in unity.
- We are united in our mission: To proclaim Jesus.
- We are united because we love one another with God's love.
- Ultimately, we can be united because we have one God.

PAUSE

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Pick a question and pray together...

Discuss Together (pick one)

- What are some values that you consider nonnegotiable? What are some issues that you have put aside for the sake of unity?
- Are there certain matters that you noticed cause division among people in the church?
 What are some ways that these matters could be addressed?

Pray Together (pick one)

- Pray for yourself and your local church, that you will begin to focus more on God and less on the things that divide you.
- Pray for God's wisdom to know which issues are worth fighting for and which are worth putting aside.
